# XIV INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON GENERALIZED CONVEXITY AND MONOTONICITY

Pisa, Italy  
September 2-6, 2024

The International Symposium on Generalized Convexity and Monotonicity is the official conference of the Working Group on Generalized Convexity (WGGC), founded in August 1994 during the 15th International Symposium on Mathematical Programming in Ann Arbor (Michigan, U.S.A.).

This symposium is the XIV meeting of a series started in Canada (Vancouver, 1980) and continued in USA (Canton, 1986), Italy (Pisa, 1988), Hungary (Pecs, 1992), France (Luminy-Marseille, 1996), Greece (Karlovasi-Samos, 1999), Vietnam (Hanoi, 2002), Italy (Varese, 2005), Taiwan (Kaohsiung, 2008), Romania (Cluj, 2011), Brazil (Rio de Janeiro, 2014), Hungary (Hajdúszoboszló, 2017) and Peru (online, 2022).
